SUBJECT: TROPHY HUNTING GILGIT-BALTISTAN DFOR THE YEARS 2014-2015

The Parks and Wildlife Gilgit-Baltistan, Pakistan on behalf of the local communities offer the following trophy hunting permits for open auction, conditional to be availed in the designated Community Controlled Hunting Areas (CCHAs) of Gilgit-Baltistan during the forthcoming hunting season 2014-2015 to be connected from October 1st 2014 to 30th April 2015.

2. Through this auction expert hunters, experienced outfitters Tourism Companies and Individuals are invited to participate in the auction process scheduled to be held in the office of the Conservator Parks and Wildlife, Gilgit-Baltistan on **20th November, 2014.** The bid will be opened for auction in the presence of bidders or their representatives at 10: am.
3. All interested Hunters, outfitters, companies and individuals are informed to deposit US\$ Dollar 10000 for Markhor, US\$ 2000 for Blue Sheep and US\$ 1000 for Himalayan Ibex as call deposit in the name of Conservator Parks & Wildlife Gilgit-Baltistan prior to participation in the auction proceedings. Interested Pakistani nationals and residence of GB can deposit a sum of Rs. 50000/- & Rs. 20000/ as call deposit for Ibex and Rs. 1000 US Dollar for Blue Sheep. Successfully bidders will be intimated instantly. However, successful hunter, outfitters, companies and individuals are required to confirm their

acceptance of availing the trophy permits by depositing the bid money in the name of Conservator Parks & Wildlife Gilgit-Baltistan on or before 20th November 2015.

The following will be the general terms and condition for trophy hunting in notified Community Controlled Hunting Areas (CCHA) Gilgit-Baltistan.

1. Hunters have to pay big game shooting license fee of US\$ 400 for Markhor, US\$ 250 for Blue Sheep and US\$ 150 for Himalayan Ibex in addition to the trophy hunting permit fee. Pakistani National to pay a sum of Rs. 5000/- as big game shooting fee for all hunts able species.
2. Hunting will be permissible only in the designated community controlled hunting areas (CCHA) or Game Reserve from October 1st 2014 to 30th April 2015 as per the days specified in the given hunting permits.
3. Hunters, Outfitters Companies and individual will have to deposit the bid money in either currency) in the given account of the Park & Wildlife Department Gilgit-Baltistan by November 20th 2014, failing which the permit will be offered to the next qualifying bidder.
4. Permit for all species and locations will be granted on first come first serve basis.
5. The highest bidder will be given preference of choice for location to hunt followed by the rest of qualifying bidders.
6. The Trophy hunting fee shall not be refunded in case if the hunter fires and animal becomes injured.
7. Eight percent of total trophy hunting fee shall go to the host community in appreciation for their efforts to protect wildlife and its habit in collaboration with the Parks & Wildlife Department Gilgit-Baltistan.
8. Successfully hunters will be encouraged to make personal donations to the valley conservation funds, managed by the communities.
9. Successful hunters, outfitters, companies and individual are supposed to arrange logistic for their hunters i.e travel, boarding and loading, import & export permits, insurance and visa etc.
10. Hunter will have collect their hunting permit in person from the office of DFOs concern after being briefed about the trophy hunting rules regulations.

11. Outfitters will not be allowed to accompany the hunters in the field. However, Parks & Wildlife Department Gilgit-Baltistan will provide Guides and Game Inspectors/Game Watchers on daily wages basis.
12. Hunters are expected to report to the DFOs in person after hunting is over and will present their trophies for examination, prior to leaving the area, conditionally to grant an NOC for the CITIES export permit to carry trophies outside the country.
13. CITIES export permit will be issued by the Ministry of Climate Change Govt of Pakistan Islamabad for hunted trophies on the recommendation of Parks & Wildlife Department and presentation of the CITIES import permit.
14. The community will be responsible to take the hunter on hunting site under the supervision of field staff of Parks & Wildlife Department Gilgit-Baltistan.
15. The Parks & Wildlife Department Gilgit-Baltistan carry's no responsibility for any accident, sickness, falling down or death of the hunter or their guides during the process o hunting.
16. If the purchase permit is not availed by the outfitter without cogent reasons then 20% bid money will be deducted in favour of the Government. Those out fitters will be exempted from this condition whose hunters come in the field and fails to attempt due to circumstances beyond his control.
17. The interested hunters of Gilgit-Baltistan will deposit Rs.50000/- as concessional permit fee and Rs. 5000/- as shooting fee for hunting of Himalayan Ibex only as a special case.
18. 15% quota for Ibex has been reserved for the interested hunters of Gilgit-Baltistan at subsidized rates of Rs.50000/- in specified CCHAs.
19. The Parks & Wildlife Department Gilgit-Baltistan reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders of trophy hunting permits without assigning any reason thereof.
